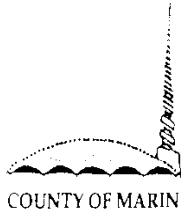

Your time and cooperation are greatly appreciated.

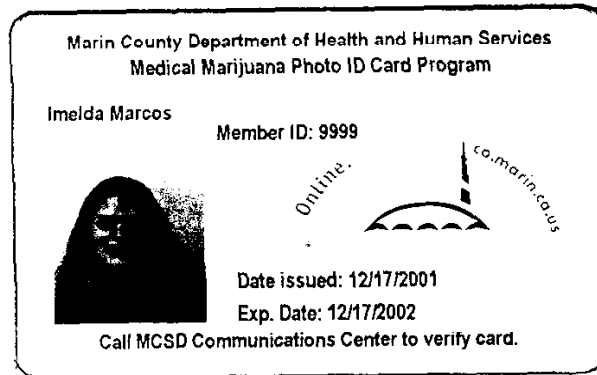
